AFTER A MAJOR EARTHQUAKE

PUT ON HEAVY DUTY GLOVES, SHOES, AND PROTECT YOUR HEAD. (Falling objects are a major cause of injury after an earthquake.)

TURN OFF YOUR GAS (EVEN IF YOU DON'T SMELL GAS, OR HEAR A LEAK OR NOTICE YOUR PIPES ARE DAMAGED). IF YOU DO TURN YOUR GAS OFF, <u>DO NOT TURN IT BACK ON</u>.

PLACE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ON SIDEWALK FOR NEIGHBORHOOD USE.

SECURE PETS IN A PET CARRIER.

PLACE OK/HELP SIGN IN VISIBLE SPOT.

CHECK ON YOUR NEIGHBORS.

OUR DISASTER PLANNING VOLUNTEERS IN LIME GREEN T-SHIRTS WILL BE IN THE NEIGHBORHOODS AND CAN HELP YOU WITH INFORMATION AND WHERE TO GO FOR HELP. PLEASE LOOK FOR THEM.

THE DISASTER PLANNING VOLUNTEERS WILL PASS YOUR NEEDS ON TO THE COMMAND CENTER.

INDIVIDUAL RESIDENTS SHOULD STAY IN PLACE IF POSSIBLE.
